We are seeking a new member for our team, to drive successful campaigns that influence EU climate policy. As a day-to-day face of Sandbag, the Policy Officer will be a strong ambassador for the organisation, not just in their grasp of policy and politics, but in building and maintaining strong relationships with a wide array of different stakeholders.

- Creating strategic plans for our campaigns.

- Contributing to relevant campaigns from other NGOs and getting NGOs to support our own initiatives.
- Contributing to public consultations, roundtables, workshops as part of civil society.
- Contributing to Sandbag's reports.
- Reporting on Sandbag's campaigns and pitching our advocacy plans to funders.
